



## **Admissions Policy**

New Way Academy is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization that seeks and accepts students for admission without discrimination against any person because of race, color, religion, national origin, disability, or gender.

Following the tenets of our mission statement, "To educate students with learning differences to fulfill their potential," the Admissions Committee adheres to the following guidelines when determining a student's eligibility and appropriateness for placement in our school.

- Parents of applicant agree to follow and comply with all of the requirements of the New Way Academy's admissions procedure.
- Student is in grades kindergarten through twelve.
- Student scores average or above on a standard measure of intelligence.
- Student can access the full school curriculum with approved New Way modifications and accommodations.
- Student has a record of acceptable social behavior and school conduct.
- Student is clean, sober, and free from any drug addiction.
- Student may have a diagnosis of dyslexia, or language processing disorder but has sufficient attending and language development skills to follow classroom instruction.
- Student may display fine or gross motor delays; however the student can navigate a school environment and participate in academic tasks with approved New Way accommodations and supports.
- Student may have a diagnosis of Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), but the disorder is managed sufficiently and the student can participate successfully within the structure of New Way without disrupting the learning of the other students.
- Student is law abiding and is not currently in the judicial system.
- Student and family agree to support and comply with the New Way discipline policy.
